Parade Information

- **DATE:** Sunday, July 3, 2010.
- **CHECK-IN:** 4:30 PM by Group Contact at Parade Booth on corner of Elm & Spring Streets.
- **ASSEMBLY:** 4:30-6:00 PM in the Meadow Staging Area – arrive early to avoid traffic delays.
- **LINE UP and MAP** will be forthcoming upon approval of your application.
- **START TIME:** 6:00 PM sharp, immediately following the Montpelier Mile Road Race.
- **ROUTE:** from the Meadow to Spring Street, to the roundabout on Main Street; down Main to State Street; on State Street past the State House, ending at 133 State Street (parking area).
- **PARKING:** we recommend 133 State Street or Montpelier High School; park & car pool.
- **APPLICATION DEADLINE:** May 10, 2011.
- **NOTES:** The number of participants is limited to 60 units.

Bring a banner/sign/poster to show off who you are and help the parade judges to identify you.

Handouts are acceptable, but throwing items is not permitted for safety reasons.

Trucks/floats/vehicles must have at least 2 spotters on the ground.

Parade will run rain or shine. If rainy, bring umbrellas, towels, galoshes, tarps, garbage bags, large sheets of plastic, ponchos, dry clothes, a hot thermos – whatever makes sense for your group!

Line up early - relax and prepare, meet, and greet other paraders. Be ready to go at 6:00 sharp.
